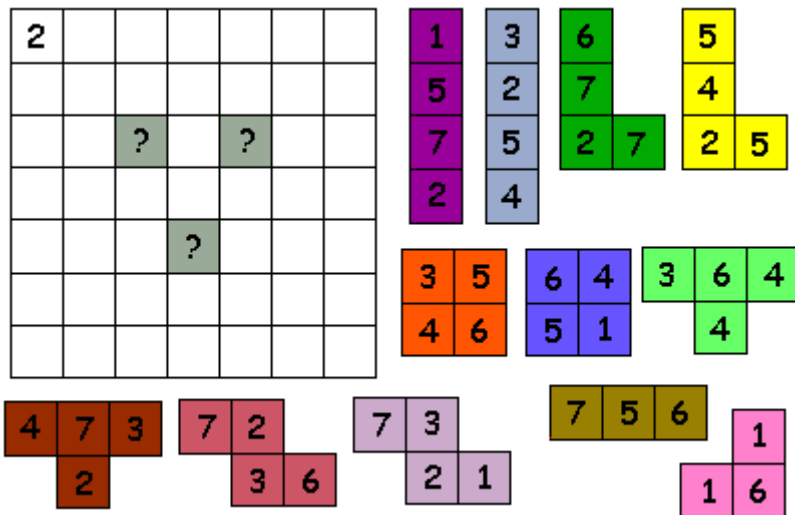


Polyominoes with numbers

Place the pieces so that each row and each column contains the digits 1 through 7.

You must fill in the gray cells by hand.

In the rest of the cells you put the trominoes and the tetrominoes.

The digits need not be upright, and you may flip over pieces.

You get one number '2'
